Jig Design Earrings

Jig Design Earrings is an intermediate class that will open up your creative options with jig structures. Jig designs are fun to make and can be used in a number of ways. In this class, you will learn how to plan out a design, use a jig, connect jig pieces together, (and enhance basic earring designs if time allows).

Note: Bead sizes are recommendations. Ensure that the beads you chose have holes that you can fit your 22 gauge wire through. Bead count will vary depending on your design choices. Please bring this sheet to class with you.

Materials Needed

20 gauge dead soft wire
22 gauge dead soft wire
2 ct. Earring Hooks
6 ct. 6-8mm focal beads
18 ct. 4-6mm beads (2mm smaller than focal beads)
20 ct. seed beads or 3mm accent beads
36 ct. 4-6mm jump rings

Round Nose Pliers
Flat or Bent Nose Pliers
Flush Wire Cutters
Bead Board
Polishing Cloth
Basic, Flat Jig with Pegs
